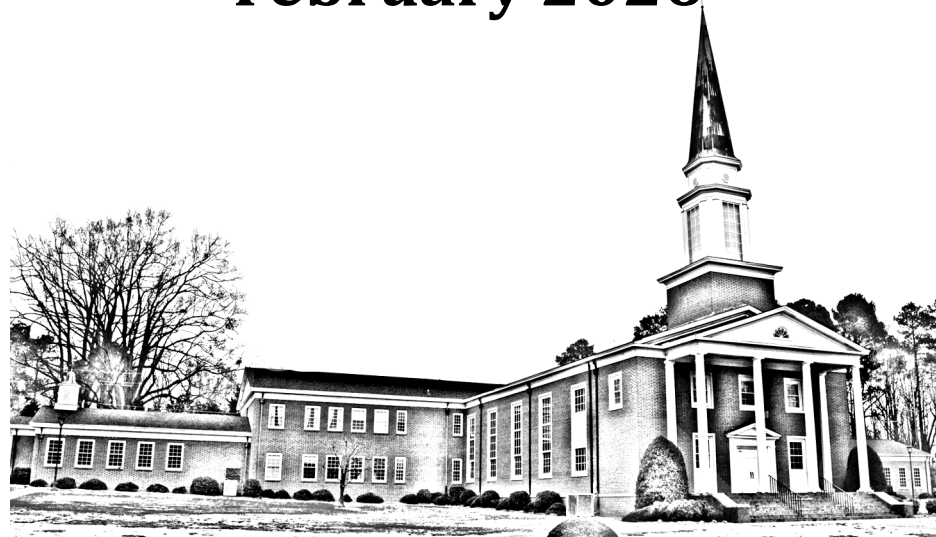

Pastor Nick's Letter February 2026

Dear Church Family,

As we step into the month of February, I'm filled with gratitude for how God has already been at work this year. January was a time of both decompression and preparation, allowing us to refocus and begin laying the foundation for all that's ahead in 2026.



We wrapped up our "Boldness" sermon series with a message on the greatest example of boldness of all, Jesus Christ. What a powerful way to start the year, fixing our eyes on the One who fearlessly fulfilled the Father's will. We've now launched into a new Sunday morning series through 1 Corinthians, examining real-life issues the early church faced and what they mean for us today. Due to the ice storm, our first message in this series was shared online only, but I'm excited to continue journeying through this rich and timely book together.

Our youth group has been diving into some of life's most difficult spiritual questions, including:

- "How do we know there is a God?"
- "How do we know we can trust the Bible?"
- "What about other religions?"
- "Why does a loving God allow bad things to happen?" It's been encouraging to watch our students grow in both conviction and confidence as they seek solid, biblical answers.

In Elevate Children's Church, our kids have been learning about the Old Testament prophets, discovering how God used ordinary people to deliver extraordinary messages. On Wednesday nights, we recently finished our series, "The Big Story," which explored God's redemptive plan through both the Old and New Testaments. We've now started a new series on Genesis 1–11 titled "Building a Strong Foundation on the Word of God." My heart is to equip our church, young and old, to trust the Word, stand on it, and see how even the earliest chapters of Scripture shape our worldview and faith.

While January gave us a little room to catch our breath, it was also a time to strategize and dream. I'm especially excited about what's coming this month. One of our major February highlights will be our first Caswell youth fundraiser, a special Valentine's Dinner where the youth will serve the meals. To set the tone, Harrison Taylor and Calvin Corbett will be providing live music for the evening. I'm thankful for everyone helping make this a special night of fellowship and support for our students.

God is so good, and I believe He has great things in store for February and the rest of 2026. It's a joy to serve the Lord Jesus Christ with you all. Let's keep walking forward in faith together.
